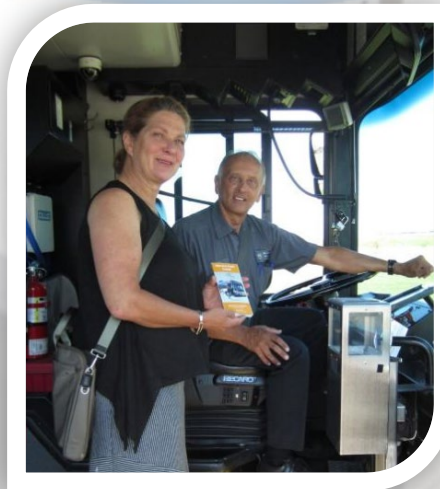

WHAT IS TRAVEL TRAINING?

Travel Training involves a series of steps from the initial one-on-one instructor training to gradually become empowered and confident enough to travel independently.

The Travel Trainer will meet with you to assess your skills and abilities, and then develop a personalized plan to address your specific needs.

The Travel Trainer will assist you throughout your entire travel training experience. Travel destinations are the trainee's choice and can include: work, school, medical appointments and recreation sites.

Travel training is provided free of charge except for your bus fare while training takes place.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

Anyone – students, seniors, individuals with disabilities, people new to Stevens Point Transit and long-time residents may utilize the travel training program.

WHAT WILL YOU LEARN?

Travel Training follows an easy, step-by-step learning process. You'll learn to:

- Plan your trip
- Read and understand route map and schedules
- Recognize bus routes, bus stops and landmarks
- Get to and from your bus stop
- Pay fares and purchase passes
- Safely cross the street and other important pedestrian skills
